Amrita Vidyalayam, Juinagar, established in the year 2001 is one among the 57 schools managed by Mata Amritanandamayi Math. Atharva Kadam scored 97.2% in 10<sup>th</sup> while Bhakti Ghanwat scored 92.4% and Sreemaya Sathyadas scored 89.8% in 12th in the Science stream and Sakshi Kadu topped the commerce stream with 84.4%.

## Something new each year.....

We are happy to inform that the school has set up a Maths lab on the first floor to enable students to explore and get a hands on experience of this interesting subject. The library was also renovated which has enabled more space for students. Mass PT and Yoga has been made compulsory for all students in order to sharpen their focus and increase their agility.

## **Club activities**

At Amrita Vidyalayam, the learning process is designed to encourage the questioning mind. The school offers a unique educational experience that prepares the next generation of global citizens to lead and make a difference in the world. #### **AMRITA FEST**

This year too the school had put forth a host of competitions under the flag of "AMRITA FEST". Exciting competitions were planned by the competition committee and students proved their merit by their active participation. #### **AMRITAM PROJECTS**

Since its inception 3 years back, students have developed a habit of contributing hand full of rice for the underprivileged society through Amritam projects. This was visible when the students and also the parents opened their hearts to donate generously towards the families affected by the Kerala Floods.

As part of the children's day program our XII std students invited members of 28 families to the school. The students had several programs which included entertainment activities, social awareness programmes. The families were also provided lunch, which was served by the students. Students gifted bags containing Rice, Pulses, Oil, Sugar and clothes to the poor families. Freedom Faith Foundation, which is a De-addiction centre in Badlapur was donated rice, Poha, Moong Dal, Soya Chunks and clothes by our students. Every month students visited the families adopted under the Amritam Projects in and around Juinagar during school hours under the supervision of their teachers and donated rice, clothes, pulses and oil. As a part of Grihamritham Project, 65 pairs of shoes were donated to Green Soles Organisation in Turbhe and more than 175lbs of carbon emissions were saved. Students learnt to make Eco-friendly Ganesha and also spread the messages

in all classrooms to avoid food wastage and celebrate a noiseless pollution free Diwali. Used uniforms were converted into bags by students, which were used for the purpose of donating. Students also have got into the habit of setting aside a small part of their desire towards the Sealing of Desire project, which helps to buy essential items for the adopted families.
