

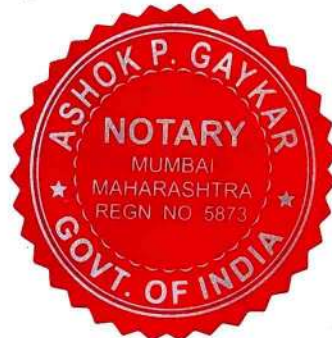

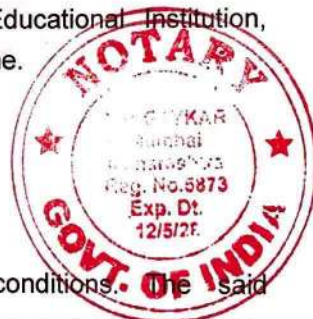
Subject: Regarding permission to start the private Primary School in the year 2001-02.

Reference: Government Letter No. VLS-1002/[1187/02] PS-3.

The Government, regarding the **Letter No. 928/03 Dt: 19/09/03** has granted permission from the academic year 2001-2002, to start the English Medium Private Unaided Primary School from 1st standard onwards starting on June 2001 to the below mentioned trust:

Name of Institution/Organization: Mata Amritanandmayi Math, Educational Institution,
Nerul, Navi Mumbai, District- Thane.

Name of School and Address: Primary School (Amrita Vidyalayam),
Nerul, Navi Mumbai, District- Thane.



The said permission depends on the following terms and conditions. The said Institution/School will be informed and made aware if the said terms and conditions are violated, then the permission given by the Government.

Terms and Conditions


- 2:1 The said organization should be registered under the Society Registration Act, 1860 and Mumbai Public Trustee Act, 1950.
- 2:2 The building of school and area should be clean and safe.
- 2:3 The school should appoint the necessary competent staff of academic and vocational qualification as prescribed by the governing body from time to time and subject to the prescribed pay scales and conditions of service by the government from time to time.

Year of Permission Granted :- 2001-2002.

School Address :- Nerul, Navi Mumbai, District – Thane.

Medium :- English.

[Permanent Unaided]

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- 2:4 Financial condition of Institution, physical facilities, management facilities etc. should be suitable to run the school.
- 2:5 The organization should implement syllabus prescribed by the government from time to time for this school as well as provide proper offices of curriculum textbooks, assessment of school academic and co-curricular activities and provide necessary facilities for this.
- 2:6 The organization must keep the prescribed records for the student and staff of the school in the form of Registers.
- 2:7 The organization needs to keep conducive environment for learning and create constructive discipline for the students in the school, as well as reflect on the consistency and regular attendance.
- 2:8 In future no changes will be made in the medium & language of school other than approved by the organization.
- 2:9 The organization must comply with the regular government's orders/rules of procedure that are released from time to time.
- 2:10 The organization must ensure that other accredited primary schools in the area are not adversely affected while admitting students to the school.
- 2:11 If a primary school is opened in a place other than the place for which the government has given permission, then the permission given by the government will be automatically considered null and void.
- 2:12 If the concerned institution does not open the school in the year permitted by the Government, then it will be mandatory to apply for renewal to the competent authority (only in the approved academic year) next year or else the permission given by the government will be cancelled. An application for renewal after one year will not be considered.
3. Elected Education Officer Primary or Administration Officer / Education Officer Municipal / Municipal Education Boards that the following things should be mainly verified before granting the permission of the government to the institution.
- 3:1 The affiliated entities are registered under both acts. (as per 2.1)
- 3:2 There are no any serious complaints against the institution.
- 3:3 None of the other primary/secondary schools run by the Institution have been stripped of their accreditation.
- 3:4 There are no complaints regarding misappropriation of the said school nor any petition is pending.

- 3:5 The financial condition of the organization is sufficiently satisfactory.
- 3:6 The organization has applied in the prescribed format with a revised fee.
- 3:7 The society has to pay a fine of Rs 100 per academic year for keeping schools open without the permission of the government.
- 3:8 The organization has completed the documents for government approval within three months.
- 3:9 The organization is required to charge the fee in the school as per the prescribed approved academic fee payment of the government.
- 3:10 While approving the school of the concerned organization, the number of students (in each unit of class) in the school should be directly examined and approved.
- 3:11 Take a written statement that you will not start upper classes or more units or change the school's location or medium without the permission of the government and add it to the inspection report.

Fulfill the above requirements of 1 to 3 and decide to grant the permission of the government to the concerned institution. If the concerned institution is unable to comply with any of these matters, such report should be submitted to this office immediately i.e. the permission granted will be reconsidered. Further action in this matter should be taken immediately and action should be taken to approve the primary school by verifying the excess or other fulfillment of the conditions.
